Survey No. 20 at Kondhwe Budruk village has been declared as reserved forest vide Notification No. 24-F, dated 1st March 1879 of the Revenue Department (Mumbai) Presidency. The area of the said Survey No. was 32 acres 35 gunthe. In the year 1934, 3 acres 20 gunthe land was deforested vide Government Notification No. S/36/13/24042, dated 5-1-1934 and the rest of the area of 29 acres 15 gunthe was still reserved as forest land until today. This land was in possession of the Revenue Department. Now, we request that it be handed over to the Forest Department for Forestry programmes. The said area is to be included in the Green Hills Programme in the surroundings of Pune. Hence we request you to please issue an order accordingly.

It appears that the said land is given to Shripati Pandu Chavan and others on annual lease basis by the Revenue Department. Hence, this is to request you

that an action may immediately be taken in this respect and the land be handed over to the Forest Department.
