The Screening Committee took note of the fact that there are 8 vacancies in the Grade the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests. These 8 posts of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests are needed to be filled up by selection from amongst the member of the service who have completed 25 years of service on merit with due regard to second to be following 15 senior most IFS officers in the grade of the Chief Conservator of Louison and including those of the same seniority (as per year of allotment in IFS) were considered in promotion:

Their Annual Confidential Reports upto 2008-09 were considered for the promotion.

The Screening Committee decided that the suitability of the officers to hold the post of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests should be judged in accordance with the criteria adopted during the previous meeting for the purpose held on 16/6/2010 i.e. by evaluating their Confidential Records for the previous 10 years out of which 5 years CR's should generally be outstanding and the remaining 5 years should be very good. The criteria for selection will be merit-cum-seniority. Accordingly the CR's of all officers in the zone of consideration were taken up for consideration.

The members pointed out that this criteria would be unfair to the officers who have been graded continuously 'very good' because they may not have the requisite number of 'outstanding' CR's. The committee took note of the G.A.D.G.R. No. AEO-1010/CR 379/2010/Ten, dated 19/10/2010, by which bench mark scores/criteria for promotion to various grades have been spelt out. This G.R. however is applicable only in respect of IAS officers. The committee desired that bench mark scores/criteria in accordance with the provisions of IFS (Pay) Rules,2007 should also be prescribed for IFS officers at the earliest which should be adopted for the purpose in the meetings to be held hereafter. For this meeting, however, the criteria adopted in the previous meeting for the purpose held on 16/6/2010 should be adopted. It was decided that the Adverse Remarks which were not communicated or against which the decision on the representation of the officer was pending should be ignored.

Accordingly, the Screening Committee found S/Shri Dr.Nandkishore, Afind Chandra, V.K.Mohan, Krishna Mohan, Sarvesh Kumar, A.K.Saxena, Ashok Sharma and Sarjan Bhagac fit for promotion. The committee found S/Shri Tasneem Ahmed, S.W.H. Naqvi, A.K.Nigam, Ramanaj Choudhari and Shri A.D.Shejale ûnfit. In case of S/Shri Shirish Asthana, R.M.Dayal the findings are kept in scaled covers.
